Make that great things: Big (or Tyler's popular mini-burger Sliders), thick juicy slabs of beef topped with cheese and/or chili, sandwiched between a freshly-baked bun. You'll have to shell out extra bucks for the delightfully crispy fries or the peppery creamy cole slaw ... (almost) as good as the burgers. Casual fun, perfect for a first relaxed date.
